A Story of Resilience: Aime's Journey from Refugee to Entrepreneur

In 2010, Aime fled the war in Congo, seeking safety for herself and her future. She first found refuge in Tanzania before making her way to the United States, later that year settling in South Dakota. There, she worked with Palance Autism, dedicating herself to helping others. During this time, Aime met her husband, and together they built a family, eventually welcoming five children.

In 2012, Aime and her family moved to Des Moines, Iowa, where she began working with TPI, a wind energy company. For ten years, she juggled the demands of her job while raising her children. However, when TPI closed in 2022, Aime saw the chance to create a new path – one that would allow her to spend more time with her family and pursue a career more aligned with her values.

Determined, Aime enrolled in Lutheran Services in Iowa's childcare program in October 2022. With their support, she launched her own daycare business in 2023. Today, Aime cares for six children in her daycare, providing a safe and nurturing space for them to grow while also staying closely connected to her own family.

Aime's story is one of resilience, growth, and the courage to start over. From fleeing her home to building a business in a new country, she has transformed her challenges into opportunities for herself, her family and her community.

Jesus is risen! Alleluia! We have made it through Lent, Holy Week, and Easter! I had a wonderful first Easter with Messiah and Bethany. We had two full churches! I wanted to offer a variety of services during Holy Week so people would have the opportunity to journey with Jesus from the triumphal entry of Palm Sunday to the regular days of Jesus' life afterwards to the institution of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday to the crucifixion on Good Friday to the silence and fear surrounding the uncertainty of Holy Saturday before finally arriving at the joy of the resurrection on Easter morning!

Our confirmation students have been busy preparing for the Healing Service on May 7th at 7pm at Messiah. They have put the service together and will lead the service. The Confession and Forgiveness Service they led in January was well attended and we hope you all will come out and support them as they lead this Healing Service as well!

I have been up to some things myself. If you receive the Burlington Beacon or the Hawkeye, then you may have seen my devotions during the month of April. This month, May, you can hear me preach on KBUR. It is a short 8-minute segment airing Sundays at 8:30am. In July I will lead worship services at Klein and in November I will have a couple of weeks when I will once again write devotions for both newspapers. I received these opportunities as part of the Burlington Area Council of Churches.

I look forward to summer worship and trying some new things like campfire worship services. These services will happen once a month (June, July, and August) around the firepits. The Finance Committee, with the backing of the Church Council, has decided to change our offering counting process.




